

PYRAMIDAL ARBORVITAE

Thuja occidentalis 'Pyramidalis'

Height: 12-25' **Spread:** 3-6'

Location: Zone 3, prefers winter shade

Shape: Columnar, narrow, pyramidal

Foliage: Soft, bright green

Notes: A tough, yet elegant and formal evergreen. Narrow pyramidal form is decidedly crisp without shearing, about half as wide as the species. Soft textured foliage appears lush and dense. Valuable for columnar effect in landscape, popular as pairs to flank entry.



RUSHMORE ARBORVITAE

Thuja occidentalis 'Rushmore'

Height: 15' **Spread:** 3-6'

Location: Zone 3, sun to part shade

Shape: Narrow, compact, upright

Foliage: Dark green, tolerant to harsh winter weather

Notes: Deep, dark green foliage forms a dense upright plant which is ideal for creating a hedge or screen as well as framing entrances. An especially hardy form whose foliage is resistant to winter burn and very wind tolerant. For a tidy, neat appearance, shear annually.
