

# DWARF SWISS STONE PINE

*Pinus cembra 'Nana'*

**Height:** 10-20'      **Spread:** 6'

**Location:** Zone 3, full sun, prefers moist soil.

**Shape:** Dwarf, pyramidal.

**Foliage:** Bluish green bicolor needles.

**Notes:** Slower growing than the species, this dwarf form of Swiss stone pine is a very hardy pine for cold areas. Similar in form and texture to the species, 'Nana' is an excellent pyramidal dwarf conifer for rock gardens, mixed borders and smaller gardens.



# SILVER WHISPERS SWISS STONE PINE

*Pinus cembra 'Klein'*

**Height:** 12'      **Spread:** 6'

**Location:** Zone 3, full sun

**Shape:** Dense pyramidal

**Foliage:** White-striped dark green needles

**Notes:** A very hardy evergreen for spatially challenged landscapes. Exceptional form is densely packed with white-striped dark green needles that produce a useful silvery plant. Accented with 3 inch long decorative violet-blue cones.
