

NORWAY PINE

Pinus resinosa

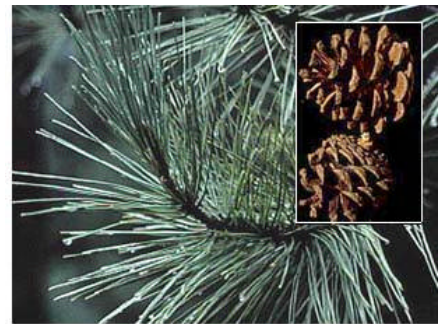
Height: 50-70' **Spread:** 25-35'

Location: Zone 2, sun to part shade, prefers sandy soil

Shape: Upright, oval

Foliage: 6" dark green needles

Notes: The plant prefers sandy and loamy soils, can grow in nutritionally poor soil and can tolerate drought. The plant can tolerate strong winds but not maritime exposure. Branches spreading with foliage tufted at the ends, resembling a fox tail.



PONDEROSA PINE

Pinus ponderosa

Height: 60-80' **Spread:** 30-40'

Location: Zone 3, sun, tolerates many soil types

Shape: Broadly pyramidal to cylindrical

Foliage: 3-needled, dark green

Notes: Large, 3-needled pine with a narrow to broadly pyramidal habit when young, becoming irregularly cylindrical with age. Tends to lose lower branches as it matures. Prefers moist, well-drained soil but tolerates drought and alkaline soils.
