

# AMETHYST CORALBERRY

*Symphoricarpos doorenbosii* 'Kordes'

**Height:** 3-5'      **Spread:** 4-8'

**Location:** Zone 4, sun to shade, tolerates wet sites.

**Shape:** Spreading, arching branches.

**Foliage:** Blue-green, crimson in fall.

**Notes:** Features clusters of unusual pastel-colored, white-to-mauve berries in late summer and fall, lasting until winter well past leaf fall. It has more uniform coloring, in a slightly bluer shade of pink. Amethyst is an improvement because it produces a noticeably more abundant crop of berries. It takes well to pruning, blooming and fruiting on first-year wood. It grows easily in average, well-drained soil in full sun to partial shade and is reliably hardy to zone 3b.
