

CRANBERRY COTONEASTER

Cotoneaster apiculatus

Height: 2-3' **Spread:** 3-6'

Location: Zone 4, sun to part shade.

Shape: Dense, spreading, arching branches

Foliage: Small, glossy dark green, bronze in fall

Notes: Superb low hedge formed by spreading branches that display an interesting herringbone pattern. Drought and salt tolerant, good for bank cover. Small pinkish flowers in early summer; 1/4" cranberry red fruit are abundantly produced in the fall and remain on branch through winter.



PEKING/HEDGE COTONEASTER

Cotoneaster lucidus

Height: 8-10' **Spread:** 4-6'

Location: Zone 3, sun to part shade, drought tolerant

Shape: Dense, upright

Foliage: Dark green, red in fall

Notes: Upright form, a natural hedge or screen; reddish flowers followed by interesting, long-lasting black fruit. Orange-red fall foliage. Thrives in poor soil, needs little maintenance.
