

# BUD'S YELLOW DOGWOOD

*Cornus alba 'Bud's Yellow'*

**Height:** 6-8'      **Spread:** 5-6'

**Location:** Zone 3, sun to part shade.

**Shape:** Rounded

**Foliage:** Green, yellow to red in the fall

**Notes:** A yellowtwig dogwood cultivar that is noted for its bright yellow twigs in winter. Tiny, yellowish-white flowers appear in flat-topped clusters in late spring. Flowers give way to clusters of blue-white drupes in summer. Fruit is quite attractive to birds and is generally considered to have as much if not more ornamental interest than the flowers. Fall color is variable, but foliage may turn attractive shades of purple-red.
