

# CHARLES JOLY LILAC

*Syringa vulgaris* 'Charles Joly'

**Height:** 8-12'      **Spread:** 8-10'

**Location:** Zone 3, full sun

**Shape:** Upright, rounded, non-suckering

**Foliage:** Green

**Notes:** One of the earlier French hybrids, this lilac is still popular. It bears smaller panicles of purple buds that turn to magenta double flowers as they open for a fabulous show!



# COMMON PURPLE LILAC

*Syringa vulgaris*

**Height:** 12-15'      **Spread:** 8-12'

**Location:** Zone 2, sun

**Shape:** Upright, vase-like, suckering

**Foliage:** Blue-green

**Notes:** This old-fashioned Lilac is the one most of us remember from our youth. A perfect informal hedge or screen, it has extremely fragrant, purple flowers in May. Color may vary from purple to lilac. The cut flowers hold up very well, and easily fill a house with their fragrance.
