

# TOR SPIREA

*Spiraea betulifolia 'Tor'*

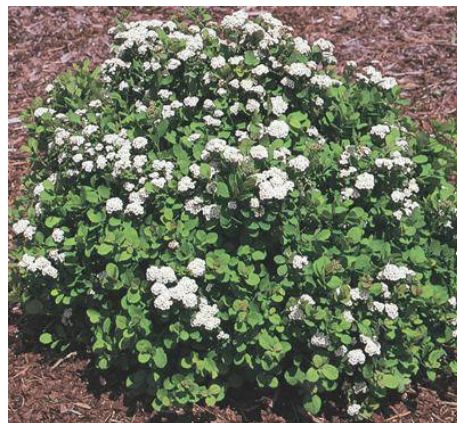
**Height:** 2-3'                      **Spread:** 2-3'

**Location:** Zone 3, sun

**Shape:** Rounded, compact

**Foliage:** Birch-like, dark gray-green, purple-red in the fall

**Notes:** Tor is a compact mound of dark gray-green birch-like leaves. Tiny white flowers cover the plant in late spring and removal of faded flowers will encourage additional bloom. Autumn brings quality shades of orange, red and purple.



# VANHOUTTE RENAISSANCE SPIREA

*Spiraea x vanhouttei 'Renaissance'*

**Height:** 5-7'                      **Spread:** 6-8'

**Location:** Zone 3, sun to part shade

**Shape:** Vase-like, arching branches

**Foliage:** Blue-green, orange to red in fall

**Notes:** With improved disease resistance, this bridal wreath displays arching boughs of snow white flowers in mid to late spring that are stunning on cloudy days or in moonlight. Fountain shape makes ideal specimen or dark green background shrub which turns orange-red in the fall. Tolerates wide range of soil conditions and is very cold hardy.
