

CRISPA CUTLEAF STEPHANANDRA

Stephanandra incise 'Crispa'

Height: 1-2' **Spread:** 3-6'

Location: Zone 3, best in light shade.

Shape: Low mounded, dense, compact.

Foliage: Reddish-bronze to green

Notes: Maple-like, deeply incised, bright green leaves turn yellow and orange in autumn. Leaves are borne on arching branches which tend to weep downward. Foliage and arching habit are perhaps the best ornamental features of this shrub. Tiny, star-shaped, yellowish-white flowers appear in loose clusters late spring. Flowers are rather attractive on close inspection, but not particularly showy from a distance.
