

TIGER EYES SUMAC

Rhus typhina 'Bailtiger'

Height: 6' **Spread:** 6'

Location: Zone 3, sun to part shade, drought tolerant

Shape: Open, wide spreading

Foliage: Chartreuse turning to yellow-red in fall

Notes: Tiger Eyes is a beautiful golden-leaved form of Cutleaf Staghorn Sumac. New growth is a lively chartreuse green, quickly changing to yellow, both colors contrasting nicely with the rosy-pink leaf stems. The branches angle upward while the deeply cut leaflets drape downward, giving it a rather oriental look. As magnificent as the summer colors are, the dramatic effect of yellow, orange and intense scarlet in autumn are unparalleled.
