

# MERRILL MAGNOLIA

*Magnolia x loebneri 'Merrill'*

**Height:** 25-35'      **Spread:** 20-30'

**Location:** Zone 4, sun, rich, moist, well-drained soil

**Shape:** Upright, oval to round crown

**Foliage:** Deep green

**Notes:** This lovely Magnolia produces masses of large white starry flowers in April. Foliage emerges bronzy green maturing to deep green.



# ROYAL STAR MAGNOLIA

*Magnolia stellata 'Royal Star'*

**Height:** 8-10'      **Spread:** 8-10'

**Location:** Zone 4, sun to part shade, avoid southern exposure

**Shape:** Densely branched, rounded

**Foliage:** Green, yellow to bronze in fall

**Notes:** In April, this hardy magnolia's pink buds open to double white fragrant flowers of 25-30 petals. An upright and densely branched plant, it has dark green foliage that shifts to bronze in fall.
