

NEWPORT PLUM

Prunus cerasifera 'Newport'

Height: 15-20' **Spread:** 15-20'

Location: Zone 4, sun

Shape: Upright branching, rounded crown

Foliage: Burgundy with red tips all season.

Notes: This cherry plum cultivar is best known for its purple foliage which emerging light bronze-purple in spring, gradually maturing to dark purple by summer and turning reddish in fall. White to pale pink, sweetly fragrant flowers appear in early spring before the leaves and are followed by purple, edible fruit in summer.



PRINCESS KAY PLUM

Prunus nigra 'Princess Kay'

Height: 15' **Spread:** 8-10'

Location: Zone 4, sun

Shape: Narrow, upright

Foliage: Green

Notes: The Princess Kay plum is a small tree or a larger shrub with an upright branch habit. This hardy plant introduced from the University of Minnesota blooms freely as a young plant with double white flowers. It has an attractive fall foliage and a darker bark color.
